


## **ASSEMBLY**




Optional: print pattern to desired size (suggested 8x11 standard paper). Cut out shape from plexiglass. Begin creating "lead lines" with stick-on lead lines or liquid leading & let dry.

Begin filling in colors for each section. You can use the suggested colors on the provided color list or choose your own!


Colors will apply opaque and dry clear or frosted. You may want to let each color dry before adding another to better see the finished look.

Continue adding colors, Crystal Clear, or frosted paints until each section is filled. Let dry, then hang or stick directly to the window with window-safe adhesive or tape.
